

Nettleton's Addition Historic District

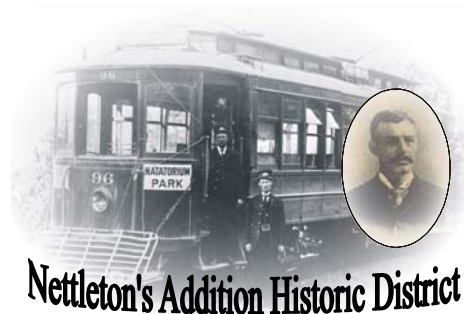
Washington State's largest historic district.



2125 W. Mission

This house is a one-and-a-half story, rectangle-shaped building with a side gable roof. It is in the center of the lot and faces Mission Avenue. It is a Bungalow with Craftsman influences. It is of wood frame construction, has rolled asphalt siding that has the appearance of brick, a stone foundation and asphalt roof. It features a small gabled entrance porch and an oversized shed-roof dormer. Additional character defining features include tripartite windows, and a brick chimney.
