The barn was built by Deb Copenhagen in the early 1950's from what I am told. I purchased the property in 1978. We have had visitors stop by our home to reminisce about how they worked at the farm helping Copenhagen's with the cattle and horses. Deb was a national rodeo champion in the 50's and still lives in Creston, WA. The farm was originally several hundred acres, but has since been broken down to 10 - 20 acre parcels. This is the last remaining large barn in the Liberty Lake area. The farm was a large cattle and horse ranch as well as a racing track for quarter horses. Copenhagen also had a large arena for rodeo events and practice that was used by many cowboys in the area. The barn was made almost entirely of cedar and is well preserved. It needs a lot of cosmetic attention and some structural attention to preserve its integrity. The barn is located 1 mile south of the StateLine in an area of rapid urban growth. It is the oldest structure in the area. It is visible from the freeway as well as uniquely stands out to local traffic

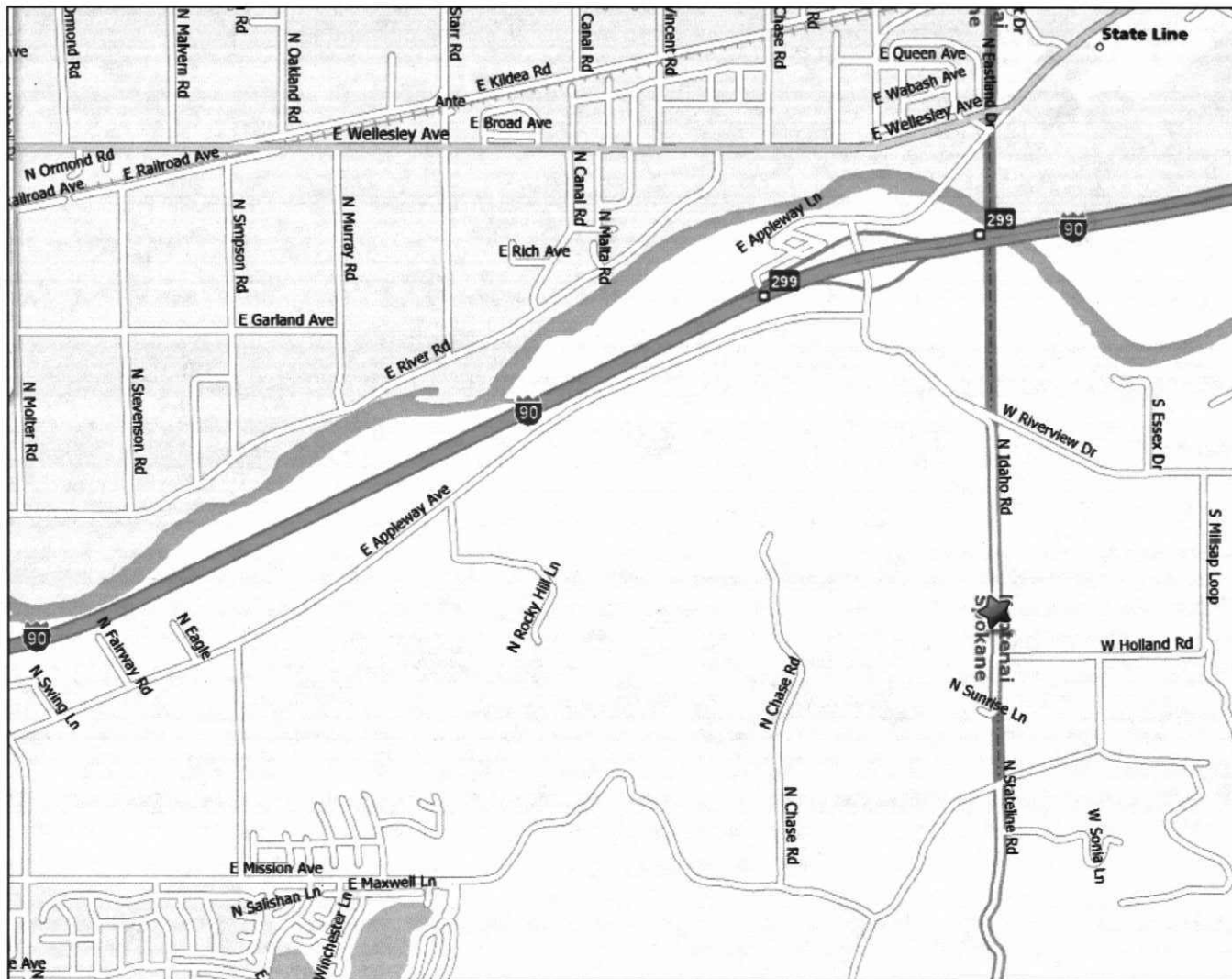
