More than 1,000 members of Spokane labor unions have been assigned to picket duty at the Davenport Hotel, where members of the Laundry Workers Union are on strike, President A. W. Dayton of the Central Labor Council said today.

Labor's new strategy in the Spokane laundry strike, he reported, is to have mass picket demonstrations at the hotel six days a week.

JOSEPH W. Marlow, 17, son of Mr. and Mrs. J. Marlow, 4417 Sixth, will take up his studies at Princeton University, to which he has been awarded a scholarship as a result of the fine scholastic record he made at Lewis and Clark High School. He was graduated from the classical course in June, taking honors in Latin and German.

SIX-MAN football definitely gained a boost in the Inland Empire sport picture today, following announcement that a five-team high school league would open play this week.

Central Valley, Cheney, Sprague, Otis and Rockford
